Over the last several years, the Clallam County Sheriff's Office has faced investigations involving financial examination. These cases are often time consuming and complex requiring specific expertise in accumulating the appropriate evidence to bring the process to a successful prosecution and closure. Often, it leads to the legal forfeiture of a significant amount of cash or other assets providing for the continued operation of specific enforcement units such as multi-jurisdictional drug task forces or other white collar crime details.

Though law enforcement officers attend financial crime courses and classes, such manner of instruction often cannot prepare them for the detailed analysis and attention to varying financial practices needed to be successful. As a result, law enforcement agencies look to those with education, training, experience and ability to achieve the results needed to bring those responsible to justice.

On more than one occasion, this agency and its investigatory units have utilized Wilson Investigative Services to aid in conducting financial investigations. Mr. Wilson's ability in the competent and focused investigation of financial matters has greatly assisted this department.
